

STRUCTURAL STATISTICAL EVOLUTION OF THE ROMANIAN TELECOMUNICATIO SERVICES

Abstract

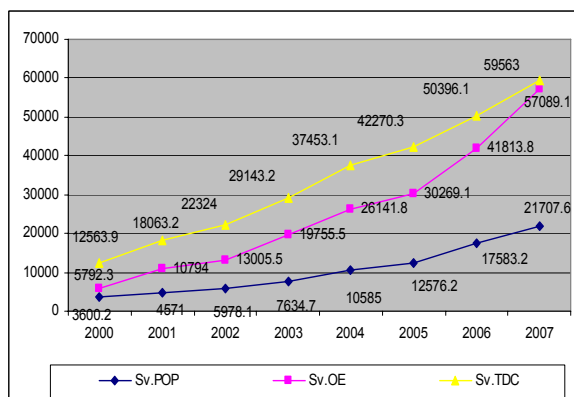
Romania's policy concerning the field of information society and the telecommunications one will be oriented towards the competitiveness increase and to expand services share on the European market.

The last years' transformations in the telecommunications field in Romania are emphasized by the establishment of their trend and pattern within the Romanian services.

The services contribute on a larger extent to the more and more efficient use of the human, material and financial services, as well as to the compliance with the population's needs, therefore, implicitly with the society's as a whole. In the same time, they stimulate the growth, the renewal and the diversification of the material assets' manufacturing, ensuring conditions for improving the process of distribution and consumption.

The evolution of services in Romania is also justified by the growth registered at the components' level

A different situation in relation to the other two categories of analyzed services is found as concerns the pattern of the transportation, storage and telecommunications services, both on activities, as well as on forms of property. It is remarkable in this category that the process of privatizing the activities is rather reduced, compared to the one of the other types in the previously-analyzed categories.

So, if the pipeline transportation has a governmental coordination, telecommunications sector has a privatization evolution, from 29,79% (2000) to 97,37% (2007). There are arguments which plead for the stringent need to develop an efficient sector of the telecommunications services in Romania, starting from the fact that they compose a real „infrastructure”, very important for the functioning of any national economy.
